Game Times + how long do they last?

Division 1 Teams Play Friday nights - LL Major(U12), Junior(U14) and Senior (U16)

ALL other Grades are played on Saturday morning, start times may vary but the game length is as follows:

When is TRAINING?

The coaches determine training times, subject to their availability. Teams train at Magdala or NR RSL Youth Club oval on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday usually between 4pm & 6pm.

UNIFORM – will be issued @ first Official Training Via Team Manager - What must be worn?

For Hawk Ball (U7) to LL Minor (Machine Pitch) (U10) the club supplies the top and pants.

LL Minor Rookie Live (U11 and up) the club provides a top, you will need to purchase white baseball pants with blue belt. All players are required to purchase a club hat and blue baseball socks.

Does my child need special shoes? Children can play in sneakers/runners/joggers/soccer boots for T-Ball but LL Minor and above **are required to wear soccer boots or non-metal cleats**. Soccer boots are OK until U11, older players are advised to seek baseball shoes from Red Stiches @ Thornleigh (consult your coach).

Should my child wear a protector or mouth guard? This is a personal choice; there is always a risk that a player may be struck by a batted or thrown ball. The club requires ALL children playing in LL Minor and up to wear protectors.

Does the club provide a child-minding service? NO! We are not a child-minding service. The club expects at least4 families per team to **Coach, Manage, Score + volunteer for Canteen**. Parents (U10 down) please be present for all your child's training sessions and games - chat to the Coach / jump on a training station and learn the game.

Who should I talk to if I have a question? The first point of contact should always be the team coach or manager.
